Hello Parents:

The following is a list of adaptations Agape Jr. Academy has made or will be making to ensure your child's health and safety as we reopen school on **August 3, 2020**. We will abide by the directives or mandates issued by the CDC and the Department of Education – Bright From the Start.

1. Daily temperature check at door before parents leave.
2. Curbside pickup and drop off. We are completing work on an app for this.
3. Hot lunch will be individually packed and served intact. We will use only disposable and individually wrapped utensils. All students will eat lunch at their desks.
4. Hand sanitizer dispensers are mounted by each exterior door for use before entering.
5. Daily sanitizing of each room including door handles, toilet flushers, sinks, light fixtures, and electronic devices that are shared.
6. Deep cleaning of classrooms using a reputable cleaning company before re-opening.
7. Parents must sign a daily temperature check sheet at drop off and indicate whether student has been in groups of 20 or more overnight.
8. Each student must have their own personal protection supplies daily.
9. Each student will be supplied with a face shield at registration/re-registration.
10. There will be no extended care.
11. Payments will be accepted through contactless methods: Zelle, Cash App, Agape Pay. No checks, money orders, or cash will be accepted.
12. If a child develops a temperature or feels unwell, parents will be asked to pick up their child from school.
13. We will be employing the hybrid method of instruction: part virtual (Mondays and Fridays) and in person (Tuesdays through Thursdays). Kindergarteners will be attending classes virtually throughout the year and will attend in person class one Friday each month in their classroom.
14. Fieldtrips/community service activities that involve transportation, and athletic activities that involve contact will be suspended for now.

15. Handwashing, proper trash disposal, and physical distancing will be practiced and encouraged.
16. Classrooms will be sanitized throughout the semester by diffusion method.
17. An outdoor classroom will be utilized daily as the weather permits.
18. We have limited the number of students per classroom and will ensure social distancing.
19. All trash bins will be covered and foot operated.
20. Birthday and other celebrations will be suspended for the time being.
21. Parent meetings will be held via Zoom.



Remember that registration has begun and will continue until the end of July. A virtual meeting for all registered students will be held on Zoom on July 29th at 10 am for grades 1 to 3, and at 5 pm for grades 4 to 8.
