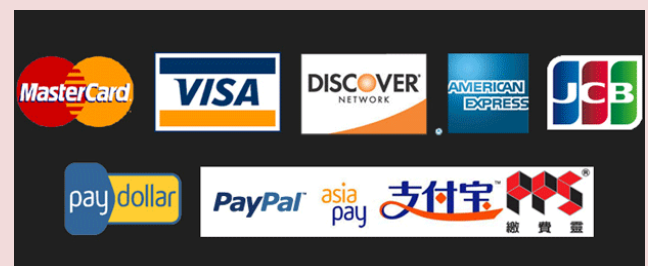
We are requesting that students arrive wearing masks. Please sign out when you leave the building.
